### 3 SUPPLEMENTARY MATHS HOMEWORK

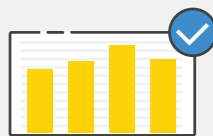
Additional practice questions to apply the skills acquired in the Maths component of the WEMT course.
